Dear Artist or Art Instructor,

The Imagine Peace Art Committee is pleased to announce Salt Lake City's Second Annual "Imagine Peace" festival, to be held September 20, 2008 at the Salt Lake City Library Plaza. As part of this festival, we will display original art on the theme of peace and justice created by local students and artists. The art need not be created specifically for this event, but must relate to the topic. Please consider submitting your artwork, and/or encourage your students to participate. If you are an artist or instructor, also consider leading an art workshop at the festival.

This is not a contest, but the art work will be publicly displayed in the Salt Lake City Library in conjunction with the festival. This experience will provide community exposure for the artist and encourage creativity. Although we are not able to sell works at the festival, we may give prospective buyers your contact information if your artwork is for sale. Until we can determine how many entries we will receive, we can accept only one entry per artist/student. If you are interested in submitting multiple works, please check back with us after August 31.

To qualify for display, the art work must meet the following conditions:

- It is an original work
- It adheres to the theme of peace and/or social justice
- It is a drawing, painting, photo, design, collage, or other flat art work
- It is less than or equal to poster size (24" x 36")
- Framing and matting, if appropriate, of the artwork is encouraged to enhance, protect and best display the art. Please also have a hook or wire for hanging it

To submit an art work:

- Notify the Imagine Peace Art Committee at [imaginepeace@imaginepeacefest.org](mailto:imaginepeace@imaginepeacefest.org) or 801.694.7677 by August 31 if you intend to submit your work (so we can estimate the number of entries)
- Deliver the art to the Imagine Peace Art Committee by September 16. (Pickup from schools may be arranged)
- Fill out and sign the Entry and Release form, and attach to the back of your artwork

After the festival, you may pick up your artwork from the Imagine Peace Art Committee by October 12. (Deliveries to schools may be arranged).
